

## Finding Course Prerequisites

1. Navigate to the Course Catalog page. On the NavBar, click the Navigator button and then go to:

### Curriculum Management > Course Catalog

2. Enter **Course ID** or the **Subject area** (e.g. Chem) and **Catalog Nbr** (e.g. 1B).
3. Click “**Search**”.
4. Click on the “**Offerings**” tab.
5. The “**Enrollment Requirements Group**” box at the bottom of the tab contains information about the prerequisites that must be met before the student can enroll in the course. The “**Detail**” hyperlink contains additional information.
